

## Chris Hastings of Birmingham's Hot and Hot Fish Club among chefs at Sunday Supper South

Another weekend, another road trip for Birmingham chef **Chris Hastings**.

The **Hot and Hot Fish Club** chef and co-owner will join more than a dozen of the South's top chefs for the inaugural **Sunday Supper South** next weekend in Atlanta.

The date is Sunday, Oct. 31, at the Westside Provision District, a dining destination and residential area in the heart of Atlanta's revitalized Westside neighborhood.

The evening begins with a cocktail reception at 5 p.m., followed by dinner at 6:30.

Guests will gather around a communal table set up along the railroad tracks for a family-style dinner celebrating the simple cooking philosophies and seasonally inspired flavors of the South.

"The South has a distinctive sense of pride when it comes not only to our regional cuisine, but also to nurturing our culture and community," says chef Anne Quatrano of Atlanta's **Bacchanalia** restaurant. "Sunday Supper South will embody that communal spirit, creating a one-of-a-kind collaboration among chefs, local farmers and purveyors, and diners themselves."

Quatrano and her husband, Bacchanalia chef and co-owner Clifford Harrison, are hosts of the event. The couple also owns Abattoir, the Floataway Cafe and Star Provisions in Atlanta.

Tickets for Sunday Supper South are \$150 for **James Beard Foundation** members and \$175 for nonmembers, with proceeds benefiting the foundation's scholarship program. Seating is limited to 150 guests.
