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you don't have to live in west midtown to know that it's the place to be in ATL these days. enter [ormsby's](#), the newest concept from warren bruno of atkin's park fame.

a classic nabe tavern with better than average fare (and an old school take on gaming), ormsby's offers tradish options with a twist. think hand-cut fries and ale-battered onion rings with a selection of sauces such as taleggio fondue or house-made cheese whiz. you'll also find hot boiled georgia peanuts, and a selection of wieners and links. or, if you'd prefer to reach the day's calorie limit by drinking rather than

eating, check out the arugula salad with lemon juice, olive oil and parmesan, or the chopped salad served with shaved chicken, romaine and the veggie works. as for the entertainment portion of the meal, be prepared for a bit of nostalgia. alongside the pool tables and dart boards, you'll find shuffleboard, a bocce court, tabletops inlaid with checkerboards and backgammon, and even an old fashioned photo booth. our advice to the single ladies? head to the bocce court, a magnet for eligible men.
