## Perrine's Wine Shop

The most important rule when buying wine is this: acquire what you enjoy drinking. Simple enough, but with a plethora of options in appellations, grape varieties, vintages, etc., it's still nice to have an expert guide you toward a bottle or two you may appreciate.

Perrine Prieur, the former acclaimed sommelier from restaurant Joel, has opened a boutique wine shop that can help you navigate through the vines. [Perrine's](#), located in the White Provision development on the Westside, features some 300 wines that Prieur has personally selected and tasted. Her inventory has international varieties, but focuses on smaller vineyards that produce limited quantities including handcrafted, biodynamic and organic selections.

The average price of a bottle is around \$25 and the wine shop offers select cheeses and oils. Also, a large table in the middle of the room is used for their scheduled and spontaneous tastings so keep a lookout on their website and Facebook page for more information.
